1. Accept the offer

4. Receive Reimbursement

After 2-10 receives your reimbursement request, our team will process and mail a refund check to the primary homeowner at the covered address. After submission, it may take up to 30-45 days to receive your check. The reimbursement amount for qualifying expenses is specified in your Agreement.
