What's included in the full system replacement?

Included Standard Parts and Labor:

- All permits
- · Supply and return plenum modifications
- All consumable items such as: brazing material, wire nuts, tape, copper pipe, elbows, tubing, PVC piping/ adapters/traps or any other items considered a consumable item
- Code upgrades such as: upgraded breakers, pump ups, locking service caps, replacing electrical disconnect, emergency drain pan, float switch, furnace/collector box, whip, gas line, stand, pump ups (in certain areas), emergency shut off switch, gas valve, drain pan or similar
- Soldering, brazing and line set modification

- Drain line replacement/modification
- Disposal of all prior equipment, reclaim and disposal of all refrigerant
- Delivery of equipment to the job site by the Service Provider
- Refrigerant used to charge the new system
- Return visits to complete the replacement as needed or warranty visits as needed
- Governmental or other certifications
- Load calculations as required
- Registration of installed equipment with the manufacturer for extended warranty

Additional Charges May Apply For Example:

- Structural modifications
- Flue pipe change out or chimney liner replacement
- System relocation from the original footprint
- Spatial constraints
- Duct repair and/or replacement (beyond the supply and return connections)
- Line set and drain line replacement or relocation
- Carpentry or work that requires the use of an additional sub-contractor
